Dr. A K Patil raises issue of eligibility criteria for professional courses such as B.Com. IT need to reduce from 45% to 40% for enroll more students for such professional courses.

Dr. S B Mahadik, nominee expert from Shivaji University Kolhapur focused on this issue and opined that this is the right of autonomous colleges to change in eligibility criteria and conditions for admissions in the colleges.
