Regarding the AQAR of the current year, he said that the Criteria-wise revised portal format has been allocated to the respective criteria coordinators and he asserted that criterion –wise finalization of criteria will be done between 6th Oct and 14th Oct.2023 and IQAC intends to undertake the common reading of AQAR in Oct.2023. He asserted that IQAC plans to submit its AQAR for 2022-23 by First week of December 2023.

He asserted that the four Deans of Faculty have prepared Credit Framework and the syllabi for first year UG & PG have been framed by sub Committees and BoS of respective departments.
